



What is WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT?

Have you ever wondered what the Office of Workforce Development does?

We had the pleasure of speaking with Frank Kobayashi, Associate Vice President of Workforce Development about the program and services and how it impacts American River College.

What is Workforce? It's responsible for the administration of Career Technical Education (CTE) programs and services. The division provides leadership for off-campus programs, instructional divisions, apprenticeship, college grants, and work experience/ internships.

How does Workforce support students and staff? The purpose of the Office of Workforce Development is to support the hopes, dreams, and aspirations of our community of teachers and learners in Career Education. Some of the key roles are to facilitate innovation, entrepreneurship, and sustainability within the Career Education based Instructional Programs which includes securing financial and physical resources necessary to promote these roles.

What's happening now? The current projects the Workforce Development Team is working on is Strong Workforce Program, Perkins Program, Department of Labor Apprenticeship Grant, California Apprenticeship Initiative Grants, Work Experience, Dual Enrollment and Career Education Outreach.

Who makes up this department? Structurally, the Office of Workforce Development includes the Associate Vice President of Workforce Development, 4 Instructional Deans; 3 Directors; 11 Classified Staff; and 3 Faculty Coordinators.

Did you know ARC has over 6,000 Apprenticeship students which makes us the largest Apprenticeship Program in the State of California? Let's give a **BIG** thank you to Frank and his amazing team!!
