NCAL UPDATES

Temporary Classified and Student Employees:

We will continue the employment of all temporary classified and student employees through the end of the Spring 2020 semester.

Summer:

- Summer 2020 will be fully online as of right now.
- Summer schedules available: April 13th, Registration begins April 20th.
- Open Enrollment begins May 8th.

Fall:

- Will Fall need to be online?! There are indicators that it might be, but no official decision has been made—a decision will be made in a couple weeks!
- Fall schedules available in early May; Registration: after May 10th.

<u>Campus remains closed.</u> Only and only in extreme circumstances, if you need to get to campus, contact your supervisor who will then reach out to Cheryl Sears FOR EMERGENCY CIRCUMSTANCES (e.g. you accidentally shut down your computer through VPN and need it turned back on). <u>REMINDER:</u> **DO NOT shut down your computer while using VPN at home!**

<u>Please DO NOT purchase supplies</u> – <u>you will not be reimbursed.</u> Refer to Los Rios FAQ's on the website. IF you have specific needs, please work with your manager.

<u>Budgets</u> – for the 2019/2020 fiscal year, <u>all purchasing and all hiring has been stopped.</u> Governor Newsom's release of emergency funds will be used to assist community colleges. We will know more about the aid after the May Revision of the Governor's Budget, applying it toward the 2020-2021 fiscal year. Look out for emails from the VPA and the Chancellor's Office.

Currently, we need to reduce the budget for the district by <u>5% for the 2019-2020 fiscal</u> year and by <u>10% for the 2020-</u>2021 fiscal year. The Chancellor's office is working on solutions that will be communicated to us soon.

<u>Commencement Ceremonies have been cancelled.</u> VPSS teams are exploring how Commencement can be done virtually—more information to come.
