ARC Happenings

We find ourselves in a world of ever-evolving circumstances, and Classified Professionals are being called on to stretch, grow, <u>and</u> shine in new ways. A great amount of planning and work happened this summer. Did you keep track?! Below are a few highlighted happenings from July and August. Check the college website often to stay updated.

Be sure to communicate with your area senator to share updates and concerns.

On Ground Classes for Fall 2020: LIMITED to programs that train first responders or those in areas that have an urgent and significant health and safety impact on our communities and their ability to respond to the COVID-19 crisis.

<u>International Students:</u> They can stay and take fully online courses for Fall 2020! (The temporary exemptions for international students taking online courses during COVID-19 is extended...for now).

<u>Athletics:</u> The CCCAA made the decision to move Fall Sports to Spring. More will be shared as Deans, coaches, staff, and athletes grapple with details.

<u>Achieve Fall Kick Off:</u> Achieve is our First Year Experience (FYE) Program for all first time in college students that supports students by Areas of Interest/majors. Achieve has success teams with the resources needed so students start right. They hosted various *virtual Fall Kick Offs August 10-13th*.

<u>HomeBase Grand Opening:</u> Pathways for continuing students are in place with specialized (by major) and personalized support to help students finish or transfer with our new HomeBases. <u>Virtual Grand Openings were August 20th</u>, 2-4pm—students are now in their HomeBase (canvas) being served daily!




"I am a Black mother with Black sons and a Black husband. Black people have being murdered throughout slavery until this current day. When I heard George Floyd call for his mom and say that he was going to die, it took my breath away. It made me sick!! Shortly after, my friend's son was murdered, then a job opportunity fell through, and I had a small electrical fire in my home.

Anxiety and depression became an issue. I have always had a desire to make jewelry and decided now is the time. It has help me transition my focus and has calmed my anxiety.

I have made so much jewelry that I decided to sell it, but I wasn't sure if people would like it. I posted on Facebook,

and people loved it! So, it is now it a hobby that I can earn extra money with.
